ADMINISTRATOR'S MESSAGE

We are eagerly anticipating the arrival of our students for the beginning of the new school year. The staff have been working hard to prepare their rooms and their routines and protocols to keep their students as safe as possible within the pandemic guidelines provided by medical health officer. By now, you have likely heard from your homeroom teacher. Please note the following reminders.

Soft Start

- Students with last names beginning with the letters A-L will have classes on Tuesday, September 8th and Thursday, September 10th. All other students will attend on Wednesday September 9th and Friday, September 11th. All students will attend all days the following week.
- Please see the map of where students and parents can meet teachers on their first day of classes (either the 8th or 9th)

Demographic Updates

- This year it will be essential that we have accurate contact information for you. Please check PowerSchool to update your demographic information. • If you are unsure how to access PowerSchool, please send a message to clavet@spiritsd.ca and we will send you directions, a username and a password.

Masks

- All students are required to wear a mask while riding the bus
- Students in grade 4-12 are required to wear a mask when they are unable to be physically distant from other students. This includes on the playground, in the halls and in the classrooms.
- Students in grades K-3 are encouraged to wear a mask, but not required to wear a mask while with their cohort. Situations in which it may not be possible to limit their cohort to 60 students include unscheduled bathroom visits and possible hallway trips. During these brief periods, students will be required to wear a mask. The school will have disposable masks for those students requiring them for these brief periods if students do not have their own.

Returns

- Students who still have library books, textbooks, Chromebooks or other school materials should plan to return them to the school on their first day. Please place all materials for return in a separate plastic bag and return them to your new homeroom teacher.

Lost and Found/Locker Contents

- Students who may still have materials at school from either the lost and found or from their lockers or classrooms will have an opportunity to reclaim their possessions at some point during the first week. Homeroom/classroom teachers will provide an opportunity to view the materials remaining at the school.

School Photos

- At this time, **parents and non-essential visitors** are not allowed in the school. As a result, we will not have our school photos taken until a later date.

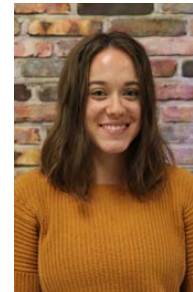

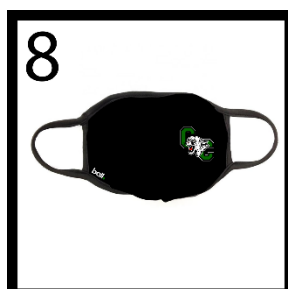
