SCC Business

Minutes from December 7, 2022 read by Rhonda, adopted as read made by Donnita.

Principles Report

Cellphone policy is under review for K-9 grades. Current policy is that they are not allowed at all unless supervised. Proposing to adjust it for 7-9 to be allowed before and after school as well as breaks. No changes for K-6.

Discussion around digital literacy for students and parents. Discussed an evening event to educate parents on digital literacy.

The annual school survey results are back. The survey is done province wide and gathers information from the students in multiple areas. Usually, the school compares in the average of other schools but this year there are some areas of interest. The administrators are continuing to review the data, should be more info later.

Fall Supper – Spring Supper – Still a go a Rhonda is comfortable with the level of understanding she has with the information from the notes supplied by Yolanda. Discussed the date and it was decided that we would move it to March 31st as it doesn't conflict with other activities. Could be labeled an Easter Supper.

Pink Shirt Day is coming up in February. There will be the option to purchase shirts for your children.

There will be a music facilitator coming in on the 19th and 23rd to conduct workshops that connect music to literacy for the K-6 grades.

The School has bid to host AAA Provincial Volleyball for 2023. Would be November 17 – 18 and a great way to show off the new school. Would be 10 teams.

Other Business

Rhonda – discussed the program “One School One Book” - The idea is that all families with kids in K-6 would receive the same book and read it along with the same schedule. Planning for March. There are daily engagement activities that would get the grades buzzing about the book. The idea is that it engages the parents at home and creates a unity among all the grades.

The book that we have chosen, The World According to Humphrey by Betty G Birney has been done by many schools around North America so many resources are available. This will be a great first book to make for a successful project.

Rhonda has discussed with several teachers, and they are excited about it. Jen Green has agreed to be the school lead and Rhonda will from the parent side. Jen will be discussing at the staff meeting on Monday.

Approx. 150 books would be needed which is a cost of approx. \$1,300. – includes a 25% discount from McNally Robinson.

Rhonda made a motion that the SCC supply up to \$1,600 for the books. Donnita second the motion. Brian double checked the available funds and we have \$1,289.35 so will need to supplement this to have enough to cover

Rhonda said there is a grant available and will apply. The grant was up to \$500.
