Sport Uniforms – Ashley discussed how the Jr Basketball uniforms look like they need to be renewed.

Peter explained that each year players contribute \$25 to a uniform fund with the intent to have \$100 in 4 years which is typically when they would need to be renewed. The fund was only started 2 years ago so they are about ½ way there. If they wanted, they could do additional fundraising to get their uniforms before that 4 year mark. He also explained that some of the players chose uniforms based on number not size so they had some players with small fitting uniforms.

Basketball hoops on high school side outside. Ashley inquired if there is anything happening to repair as one of the backboards is without a hoop. It has been submitted to facilities but might take some time as it is a low priority. It is possible for parents to make the repairs. As long as they are only installing the rim or replacing/painting the backboard, Brian agrees they do not need to submit anything to facilities. However, if they want to install additional poles that would need to be submitted. There used to be 5 poles total, 3 were removed to make room for the new portable classrooms. The 3 poles and back boards/rim are still onsite and could be used to make the repairs.

Clavet has done awards ceremonies in the past but found them to be poorly received/attended and with little motivation to the students to achieve. For many years they did academic achievement awards which were nice for a handful of students but demotivating for the rest of the class. And even then, those students receiving the awards sometimes didn't attend even if informed ahead of time. They have also tried behavioral achievement awards, but they also did not receive well. The las awards ceremony was in 2018. The amount of time and volunteer hours need to pull of the event was deemed to much for the participation of the students and their families
