SCC Business

School Report

Current Enrollment is 708 students. Ended school year in June with 691.

Staffing: Six new staff (some are returning staff).

SLC for SCC: We are anticipating we will have members from the SLC attend the SCC meetings this year.

Personal Electronic Devices Policy: Most have adjusted well to the new policy. There is a process in place for individual or classroom exemptions. Feedback has been positive from teachers that students are communicating well and are more interactive.

Chromebooks: Currently Clavet has three students to one Chromebook ratio which is not nearly enough. It is an option for students to bring their own Chromebook or laptop. The division does not compensate for loss or damage. There is a separate wifi available for these personal computers.

Criminal Record Checks: Criminal record checks are required every three years. A compliance form is required on the years in between the record checks.

Hot Lunch: First lunch is on September 20th. There are the same three vendors with a few adjustments to the items available.

Art Club: An after-school art club will be starting this fall and running until March.

Basketball Camp: Jeff Randall is offering a basketball club for any interested students in grades 7-12.

School-wide Assembly: The theme for this assembly was we are a big family. Assembly started with K-6 students and then the grades 7-12 joined.

Terry Fox: Having some fun with fundraising goals this year.

Sports and activities: Fall sports and activities have begun with volleyball, cross-country and the Shrek musical.

Halloween Dance: The SCC has helped organize the elementary dance in the past. The high school dance has been school organized (SLC). The SCC is unable to help organize this year due to the dates of the Fall Supper and the Book Fair.

Bussing:

- Bus drivers have been instructed not to let kids off the bus until 8:35. Students should not be dropped off before 8:35.
- Departure time has changed by five minutes and is at 3:20 this year.
- K-3 students will be provided bus labels when they are ready to assist them in getting to the correct bus.

Day Planners: Teachers were given the option to have day planners for their classrooms to reduce expenses and waste.
