SCC Business

Minutes from September 11, 2024, read by Linnea. Motion to adopt by Ashley Dennis, seconded by Jaimie Tuchek. Passed – minutes adopted.

School Report

Milk Program: Feedback has been mixed about reintroducing this program. It would require parents purchasing a cup for the year. Would need to discuss how to mitigate spills and ensure kids are cleaning their cups well. A poll, including how milk program functions at Clavet, to be facilitated prior to restarting program.

Personal Electronic Devices: Staff have the ability to request individual and classroom exemptions for specific projects and activities. There have been less than 10 phones turned in to the office due to students not following new guideline.

Chromebooks: The students who have brought personal Chromebooks are mainly in grade 10-12. These students seem to be enjoying having their own device and no issues have occurred. School is exploring grant options for additional Chromebooks.

Halloween Dance: The Junior SLC is hosting a Halloween dance for the elementary students. It will be held on Tuesday, October 29 from 5:30-7:30. Senior SLC decided to help with junior dance in lieu of hosting a dance for high school students.

Acadience Testing: Acadience has replaced previous testing for grades 1 through 3 students. New training has been available for teachers. School has opted to use paper and pencil option for now. They are faster to administer and provide more details to transfer to action.

Administrator's Meeting: Focus was to advance equitable student programming and offer more diversity and equity in school division. Desire to offer more options. There has been a change in graduation requirements; there are two less compulsory courses and two more electives. Clavet comes up with electives based on teacher expertise. Several Clavet students are taking courses through the Saskatchewan Distance Learning Centres (SDLC). Clavet is proud to offer a similar number of courses as schools in the city. The school is an extra-curricular hub in our community.

Other Business
