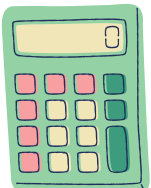
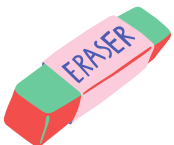
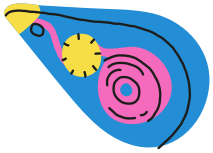


# 7/8 BOLTON SUPPLY LIST

Please send all materials to school and be prepared to resupply throughout the year.



- Large, zippered binder suitable for multiple subjects
- 8-10 dividers for binder
- 2 packs of loose-leaf
- 1 pad of graph paper (1/4" squares or larger)
- Two 150 - 200 page coil notebooks
- 1 roll of scotch tape
- 1 roll of masking tape
- Pencil Case large enough to fit the following:
  - 10 - 20 Blue or black pens
  - Pencils (At least 50. Please send more than you think your student can possible go through. If you think you are sending too many, it's still probably not enough!)
  - 4 Large glue sticks
  - Highlighters
  - Scissors
  - Pencil crayons, unscented markers
  - Sticky notes (10 - 12 3"x3" pads - you don't need all of them at once)
  - 2-3 White Out (the tape kind is best)
  - At least one pack of dry erase markers (we use these **every day**)
  - Permanent markers (fine and thick tip)
- Geometry Set
- Scientific Calculator (under \$30)
- French/English Dictionary (Collins or Collins-Roberts is best)
- Red duotang for French (grade 7s only)
- Green duotang for French (grade 8s only)
- Gym outfit (t-shirts, shorts, non-marking light soled running shoes)
- Clear safety glasses for IA
- Sketch book for Art Class (8" x 10" or larger)
- Oil pastels for Art Class (grade 7s only)
- 1 fine tipped black sharpie for Art Class (grade 8s only)
- 2-3 Kleenex boxes for classroom use
- Old magazines, photographs, scrapbook paper, etc. for collage activities
- Optional:
