Trustee Report

School Report

Welcome Back BBQ was great and well received. It was a wonderful community outreach.

School enrollment at Clavet is currently 725. There are two all-male classes due to 2:1 male-to-female ratios in grades 9 and 10.

Complex Support Teacher role is new to us this year. Learning Support Teachers also in place for grades Pre-K-2, 3-6, 7-9, and 10-12. Due to these roles province-wide, the substitute teacher list is quite short this year.

Counselling is not full-time at Clavet this year. It is only being offered four days a week.

Newsletter is being cancelled. A message will be sent to parents.

New website is expected to go live in next two weeks. Kristen is working on this for Clavet within guidelines of district. There may still be some spots where we can add information specific to our school community.

Playground: River Pirates are committed to doing work but development is on hold waiting for details from South Corman Park School.

Greenhouse: Huge kudos to Laura Williams for connection to get this project moving. \$80k downpayment has been issued to start greenhouse. Plans have been approved for a 32' geodesic dome greenhouse, construction to start within the next few weeks. A committee will need to be established that hopefully will include staff, parents, and community members. Fall Supper would be a great opportunity to have a display available to drum up interest in this project.

Kevin Cumming is the new athletic director for Clavet.

Healthy Hunger is expected to start soon. Also hoping grilled cheese days can continue to be offered.

Caretakers are not scheduled for weekends. For those wishing to hire on a weekend, it costs \$30/hr with a minimum \$90 callout.

SCC Report
